- Ordained at Yeshiva University in 1980 and received a Masters in Medieval Jewish Philosophy (philosophy during the time of Maimonides) and an MBA in Finance from NYU Business School.
- Served for a few years as a pulpit Rabbi in Jersey City, NJ.
- Founded and grew a litigation consulting company in NY area called DOAR and worked as a jury and strategy consultant on several famous cases, most notably the Insurance litigation resulting from the destruction of the World Trade Center on 9/11. Wrote and contributed to several books and treatises on the subject of litigation strategy, jury consulting, and graphics. Sold the company and retired from the industry in 2008.
- Made Aliyah in 2010 where he lives on an agricultural village, Beit Zayit, right outside of Jerusalem.
